What is Awana and who can attend? Awana is a weekly program that introduces children to Christ and builds a Biblical foundation for their faith. Awana clubs are open to all children, age 2 to 5th grade, regardless of church affiliation. Children attend age appropriate clubs as follows:

- Puggles: 3 years prior to Kindergarten
- Cubbies: Preschool program, 2 years prior to Kindergarten
- Sparks: Kindergarten, 1st grade, 2nd grade
- T & T Girls: 3rd – 5th grade
- T & T Boys: 3rd – 5th grade

When is Awana? Awana is held most Wednesday evenings from 6:15-8:00PM from September through May.

What do kids do at Awana? A typical Awana club night includes handbook time (with an emphasis on Scripture memory), a Bible lesson, game time, and a variety of special events.

What does the word Awana mean? It's an acronym for Approved Workers Are Not Ashamed. This is a Bible verse found in 2 Timothy 2:15.

How do I sign my child up? Fill out a registration card. Next, on an order form, mark the items needed to purchase for your child's club. Payment may be made using cash or a check made out to Suburban Bible Church. If you are buying items for more than one child, one check may be written to pay for all your children's items and their participation fees.

What items do I order? Your child will need the following items:

Puggles (children 2-3 years old)

- Take Home Cards \$10
- T-shirt \$12 (optional)

Cubbies (2 year program prior to Kindergarten)

- Handbook \$12 (yearly)
- Vest \$12 (optional – worn both years to display awards)

Sparks (Kindergarten-2nd grade)

- Handbook \$12 (yearly)
- T-shirt \$14 (optional - worn all three years of Sparks)

T&T (a separate boy and girl program for 3rd – 5th graders)

- Handbook \$12
- T-shirt \$18 (optional - worn all 3 years to display awards)

Participation Fees are an important part of Awana. 100% of the fees go back to the children to help pay for supplies, special events, and class celebrations. Fees are \$25 for the year for all clubs.

What is my role as a parent? Your child will be working on memorizing certain Bible verses every week. Helping your child memorize these verses is a great way to get involved. Some weeks there may also be a short activity for you to complete with your child. If you have any questions, feel free to talk to your child's club director or contact the church office.

Throughout the year, be sure to read calendars, newsletters and notes sent home with your child. These contain important information about upcoming events.
