I pray this letter finds you well and I thank you if you were able to fill out our survey about Awana this fall. Your feedback greatly helped with planning for this year. It was also good to see those of you that were able to make it to the Award Open House.

I know there have been questions about this upcoming Awana year, and I apologize for not being in touch sooner. We have had a lot of logistics to work out, and wanted to get you as much information as possible all at once.

Club Meetings:

We will be trying to hold in person Awana club starting Wednesday, October 7th. The time will be 6:30-8PM, with no snacks, rally time, or gym time (excluding T&T Boys).

Not all clubs will be meeting each Wednesday, as to limit people in/out of the building and the amount of cleaning that needs to be done by staff, as well as help with social distancing within each club.

As of right now, Puggles, Cubbies, and both T&T groups would be meeting starting October 7th. The following Wednesday, October 14th, we would have the 3 Sparks (K, 1st and 2nd) groups meeting and would keep an every other week schedule through November.

Registration:

We have online registration available for our clubbers, with online payment options for families. The fees listed include both dues and book for each clubber. We encourage you to register online, so we can again reduce the number of people in and out of the building, and be able to see how much interest we have, but in-person registration and payment will be available on meeting night too.
