I pray this letter finds you well and I thank you for considering our Awana program this fall. Below are some details that I pray will help you when deciding to register your child/ren for Awana this year.

**Club Meetings:**

We will be starting an in-person Awana club starting Wednesday, October 6th. The time will be 6:15-8PM. Snacks will be given in social distanced situations and we hope to have gym again during our night. We will not have our large group rally time for our kindergarten and older clubbers; instead, these clubbers will go directly to their club room and each club will have some table activities for the first 15 minutes of club, with regular instruction time starting at 6:30PM.

All clubs will be meeting weekly through early May 2022.

**Registration:**

We have online registration available for our clubbers, with online payment options for families. The fees listed include both dues and book for each clubber. We encourage you to register online, so we can again reduce the number of people in and out of the building, and be able to see how much interest we have, but in-person registration and payment will be available on meeting night too. **Safeguard Policies:**

As with everything these days, things may need to change as we adapt to new circumstances, and I ask for your understanding and patience as we work through things. Also, I ask for you to pray for this Awana year and that we are able to be safe while continuing to provide a quality program.
